NEW ROLLER FLOUR MILLS, NEW BARNES.

The New Barnes Mill, situated near St. Albans, is an entirely new building, and contains an up-to-date "Simon" Roller Plant, erected early in the present year for the production of $1\frac{1}{2}$ sacks of flour per hour.

It is the property of the landowner, and situated in the midst of his estate, which constitutes one of our large home wheat growing areas

The installation is complete with new Wheat Cleaning Plant and Grain Silos for the storage of 840 quarters of wheat. There is also a Provender Mill erected in conjunction with the Roller Plant.

The Mill is driven mainly by water power, by means of a "Simon" Turbine, specially adapted for the circumstances, and is also equipped with an Oil Engine for auxiliary power.
