Possibly 12 sided

Over 200yr old

Old man of 90 said he only ever remembered 2 sails

Dem. C. 1895 or earlier

2pr French stones, dresser, (Auction 1848)

In 1873, conveyed from late Rich. Brook to Jacob Mayes

In 1838 conveyed from Samuel Alexander to John Biddle Alexander

1840 – Edward & Samuel Cadman mortgaged it to Richard Brook for £300

31. dec. 1839 – conveyed to Chas Moore for year (land only?) by Dykes Alexander

26. 8. 1774 Covenant land – Mr & Mrs Thetcalfe to Thomas Butcher, m/w

↑ of Wm Mkt

& Geo <Henent> - piece of land & tenement

abstract of tithe, 2. 5. 1847 (Tenants' items)

- going gears etc. – 16 feet of long strap round strap jumper strap
- 2 shoe brasses sack rope pulleys and cords round rope clothing stage
- 4 sail cloths break line 2 regulator straps
