

## Peter Dolman - Stanton Windmill (Upthorpe Road) Notes, Documents and Cuttings

1	Peter Dolman	Handwritten Notes	Handwritten notes by Peter Dolman, detailing the internal plan of Stanton Mill - presumably on some of the repairs he wished to carry out. Includes sketches and drawings of Funnel Bottom, End frame, Top, Front Door, Back Panel, Bolter, Pulley and Reel.
2	Peter Dolman	Word-processed Document	A report by Peter showing the progress that was made at Stanton Post Mill in the year 2000.
3	Peter Dolman	Copy of Drawings/Sketches	Numerous copies of drawings/sketches made by Peter Dolman, with measurements of pieces such as the elevations, brakewheel, sails and other parts of Stanton Post Mill. Made from various dates.
4	Unknown	Typed Document	A typed document by an unknown author, detailing the history of Stanton Post Mill, including some of the owners and part of the restoration history. No date given.
5	Various (including Peter Dolman, Chris Hullcoop, D. J. Albon, and the Suffolk local planning authorities.)	Copies of Typed Documents & Cutting.	A collection of documents and a newspaper cutting dealing with the planning permission for any alterations to Stanton Post Mill and the change of use from Corn grinding to storage. There are numerous documents here dealing with the planning permission, such as from D.J. Albon, the Planning officer, and copies of the actual planning permission document itself, along with a statement from Peter Dolman and Chris Hullcoop from the Suffolk Mills Group with regard to the change of use of Stanton.
6	Chris Hullcoop	Word-processed Document	Some detailed documents compiled by Rutters, advertising the sale of the Mill Farmhouse, Windmill, and 40 Acres at Stanton and Bardwell in Suffolk. The documents include all the details of the areas of the mill that are up for sale, and also includes a plot map giving a visual reference. Dated September 1974.
7	Edward M. Ellis	Typed Document	A typed document taking the form of correspondence, from Edward M. Ellis to Peter Dolman. Ellis gives some detailed family history information on Henry Alliston and his family, who at one time was the owner of Stanton Post Mill. He also encloses a copy of Alliston's last will and testament. Some information is also included on William Trudgett and mentions of him in the London Gazette.
8	Various (mainly Peter Dolman)	Handwritten Notes	Some handwritten notes, mainly by Peter Dolman explaining some of the family history behind Stanton Post Mill. Also included is a preliminary copy of the wording of the intended plaque dedicated to Richard Duke (who owned the mill between 1986 - 1993), and some notes made by Peter from the SPAB files on Stanton Post Mill. Also includes more SPAB notes, particularly from Rex Wailes, and also some notes on Rex Wailes' inspection of Stanton Post Mill.
9	Unknown	Copies of Maps	A selection of copied maps, ranging from Tithe maps to Ordnance Survey maps showing the placement of Stanton Post Mill at various periods in history.
10	Peter Dolman	Sketches/Drawings & Copies	Some sketches and drawings by Peter Dolman of the Stock Side Elevation, Front Elevation and Whip side elevation of Stanton Post Mill. Also includes a copy. Dated 1998.
11	Peter Dolman	Handwritten Notes	Some handwritten notes by Peter Dolman explaining the family history of Dora Hoggett (nee Bryant). The notes describe the memories of Dora (presumably Peter interviewed her) and, in particular, explore the history of the Bryant family who were millers there during the Second World War.
12	Peter Dolman & SPAB	Word-processed Document and Handwritten Notes	A selection of word-processed documents and some handwritten notes by Peter Dolman and the windmill and watermill section of SPAB. The first, from Peter, lists each item of repair that was due in 1997 and also the prices to go with it. Includes repairs on items such as the Fanstage, Outer Sails, Inner Sails, Buck Framing and Cladding, Floors, Post and trestle, Machinery and other items. This includes some handwritten notes on the expenses for Stanton between 1998 and 1999. The material by SPAB is a booklet listing some general principles and practices in repairing windmills.
13	Peter Dolman (and possibly unknown others)	Copies of Drawings	A selection of a copy of drawings, including a copy of sail drawings by Peter Dolman, drawings of Stanton post mill itself, cross-sections of Stanton Post Mill and drawings and sketches of the machinery used inside the mill.
14	Peter Dolman	Booklet of Information	A booklet of information on Stanton Post Mill, compiled by Peter Dolman. Gives a brief history of the mill along with details of its machinery.
15	Rex Wailes, Helen Lloyd, John Hunt, A. A. Clarke, J. Bryant	Copies of Correspondence	A whole collection of correspondence relating to Stanton Post Mill, dating from 1937 - 1939. The correspondence mainly deals with various repairs being made to the mill, with Rex Wailes having made most of the correspondence, but with contributions from others including representatives from SPAB. Other subjects that are included in the correspondence include the death of one of the Bryant family, and also the prices and expenses for the cost of repairs on the mill. All of this correspondence was lent to Peter by Michael Bryant.
16	Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission for England	Typed Document with Handwritten Notes	Several Ancient Monuments Records Forms that contain handwritten notes by numerous inspectors. The forms contain information and descriptions of the owners of the mills at the particular time they were visited, plus an account of the site management detailing what state and condition the mill is in at the particular time.
17	Unknown (possibly Rex Wailes)	Copy of Handwritten Correspondence	A copy of handwritten correspondence possibly from Rex Wailes to Chris Hullcoop. The writing is difficult to make out, but various Suffolk mills are discussed in the letter.

18	Gerald T. Brace	Word-processed Document	A letter from Gerald T. Brace to Peter Dolman, giving a quote about the timber and treatment needed for Stanton Post Mill.
19	Kate Clark, English Heritage and others	Word-processed Document	A collection of documents specific to the conservation and management of listed buildings, with certain guidelines and rules on what to do and how to preserve the listed buildings. Presumably this was used by Peter in his preservation and restoration of Stanton Post Mill.
20	Peter Dolman	Handwritten Notes and Word-processed Document	A wide range of handwritten notes and word-processed documents by Peter Dolman mainly related to the restoration and preservation of Stanton Post Mill. Many of the handwritten notes are measurements, sketches, prices and costs for the various parts of the mill that were going to be restored by Peter. The word-processed documents are plans of the programme of repair that was due to be carried out on Stanton Post Mill by Peter, and include the individual items such as timber and machinery for the mill, including the prices and costs of the items and the order that they were due to be carried out.
21	Evening Star	Three Newspaper Cuttings	A couple of newspaper cuttings relating to Richard Duke, a former mill owner of Stanton Post Mill. One of the cuttings is from 1990 and the others are from 1993. Two of the cuttings explores Richard's history and childhood and the history and restoration of Stanton Post Mill along with it, and the other cutting is a tribute to Richard after his death in April 1993.
22	Durrant's Press Cuttings	Copies of Newspaper Cuttings	Some copies of Durrant's press cuttings, all relating to Stanton Post Mill. Most of the cuttings explain the efforts to try and save and restore the mill in 1938.
23	Unknown	Adverts and Booklets	Three booklets of information on Stanton Post Mill. The first is one produced in 1938 which seeks to raise funds for the repair of the mill. The second advertises the need for a new owner for the mill, and the third is a booklet written by Peter Dolman that outlines a history of the Post Mill itself.
24	East Anglian Daily Times	Newspaper Cutting	A newspaper cutting from the East Anglian Daily Times from the 7th June 2002. The cutting is a feature about Peter Dolman, showing Peter standing in front of Stanton windmill and describing the restoration of the mill up until that point.
25	Bury Free Press	Newspaper Cutting	A newspaper cutting from the Bury Free Press from Friday August 11th 1995. An article about Peter Dolman and the history of Stanton Post Mill and mills in general. Also features a small part on the then volunteer, Luke Bonwick.
